Objective: to reduce the daggerboard surface still saving current boards partially cutting away the front edge

Reasons: the current daggerboard seems to be too wide related to other boat characteristics (such as weight, sail area, boat shape, rudder dimensions and so on).
The proposed change will reduce the submerged surface moving aft the LRC.
