Rigging is in good race condition with all lines, blocks, halyards, and other systems likely to withstand sustained 25 knot conditions without failure.

"C": More than ten years old. All fiberglass hull construction, new design tapered mast. Magic box jib halyard adjustment, adjustable jib leads. Hull is in good condition. Rigging is in good race condition with all lines, blocks, halyards, and other systems probably able to withstand expected wind conditions for the event, without failure.
